ANNUAL FEE PAYMENTS

Our annual fees for 2027 (including our boarding fee) are due as follows:

A three-month instalment plan is available for invoices issued on 1 October and 1 April.

Payment of the Semester 1 2027 invoice confirms re-enrolment and acceptance of the College's terms and conditions (available on our website, www.wesleycollege.edu.au).

Families experiencing financial difficulty should contact the Fees Office as early as possible to discuss available support and payment arrangements. If fees are unpaid or overdue, the College may take steps to recover amounts owed, including taking legal action.

Change to Consolidated Charge invoicing for 2027

To align the timing of all annual fee components, the Consolidated Charge will now be invoiced at the same time as Tuition Fees and the Infrastructure Levy.

As a result, existing families will receive a one-off transition invoice on 1 October 2026 that includes both:

- the Semester 2 2026 Consolidated Charge; and
- the Semester 1 2027 Consolidated Charge.

Families who require additional time to pay the transition amount are encouraged to contact the Fees Officer before the due date to discuss available payment arrangements.

BUS FEES TO/FROM CAMPUS

Students who use a College-arranged bus service for travel to and/or from school will be charged \$1,000 per student per year (or part thereof). The fee contributes towards the cost of providing the service, whether delivered by the College or a third-party operator. Most intraday transport (e.g. for sport, excursions) is included in annual fees and charges.

HEALTH COVER

The Australian Government requires that all international students holding student visas must have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for the entire period of their student visa and stay in Australia. Please refer to the Department of Immigration and Border Protection website www.border.gov.au for all relevant information. It is the responsibility of applicants to purchase OSHC prior to commencing the online visa application and provide evidence of the policy and cover dates to Wesley College prior to commencement.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

One term's notice in writing to the Head of Campus is required advising the withdrawal of a student from the College; otherwise a charge equivalent to one term's fees will apply. This means that notice is required by the end of Term 3 for the following year.

Two term's notice is required advising the withdrawal of a student from four-year-old ECLC. This means that notice is required at the end of Term 2 for the following year; otherwise a fee equivalent to one term's fees will be payable.

DISCOUNTS

Family Discounts

At Wesley, coeducation is central to our vision for learning, as is our commitment to keeping children in one family together.

A family discount applies to the Tuition Fee only, where three or more siblings attend Wesley College. The discount is 10% for the second child, 20% for the third child and 50% for the fourth and any subsequent siblings.

The discount is automatically applied to your account if applicable.

The family discount does not apply to the Consolidated Charge, Infrastructure Levy or any other fees and charges that are billed to your account.

Students who have been granted other forms of fee assistance, such as Scholarship, are not entitled to receive family discounts.

Early Payment Discount

A discount of 2.5% is available where the total annual fees are paid in advance, e.g. Full 2027 fees and charges by 31 October 2026. The discount applies only to the Tuition Fees and Consolidated Charge and does not apply to other fees or levies.

OTHER EXPENSES

Estimated weekly living expenses

It is estimated that each student will require approximately \$100–\$150 per week to cover the following expenses:

- Transport
- Mobile phone
- Accommodation
- Medical
- Pocket money for miscellaneous items such as haircuts, clothing, entertainment, eating out, etc.

Estimated books and uniform expenses

Further costs will be incurred for the purchase of a uniform (range from \$1,500 – \$2,000), books and stationery (approximately \$600) and any sports equipment required.

STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Wesley College prides itself on the level of care and the provision of a safe learning environment for all students. Even in the safest environment, accidents and injuries can still occur.

The College strongly recommends that every family at the College takes out private health insurance with full private health cover from a reputable insurer, as the cost of medical expenses to parents for accidents can be substantial, especially from sports injuries. The College also purchases a Student Accident Insurance annually which is available free to all families.

The College encourages payment by BPAY or Direct Credit Transfer wherever possible. As these methods generally incur lower transaction costs than credit card payments, they help us direct more resources towards educational programs and services for students.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Fees are reviewed annually and are subject to change, at the College's discretion. Fees shown are the net amount payable by families after applicable Australian and Victorian Government funding has been applied. All fees and charges shown are inclusive of GST where applicable.

Other costs will arise during your child's education. School uniforms are compulsory for ECLC to Year 12 students. Students can choose between new and second-hand uniforms of good quality. Please contact our uniform supplier Noone if you wish to understand. The College will provide booklists of required materials for a student's learning each year.

These costs aside, additional charges generally will depend on a student's involvement beyond our standard educational program. For example, after school or before school care, additional music tuition, selective trips and camps, unreturned library books, lost locker locks, etc. These can vary and often depend on costs driven by external suppliers. We are happy to provide an estimate of these costs on request and they otherwise will be advised to you at the relevant time.
